DEACON'S REFLECTIONS

Maybe you're baking, or cleaning or decorating. On Sunday we might sing, "Come, thou long-expected Jesus." Advent gives us a time to reflect and prepare for God's coming in Jesus. And yet, while we get things ready for Jesus, we know that he's already present. How can we wait for him and respond to his presence at the same time?

Contemplation and Action are partners in the spiritual life. As we pray and worship, preparing to receive the infant Jesus, we can also remember the man Jesus became. We can remember his message: When I was hungry, sick, a stranger... you fed, treated, welcomed me. Advent can be a time of contemplation and action, a time of prayer and response. Maybe you can pair Sunday worship with a bit of volunteering at a charity you support; or take part in one of the parish's outreach activities that you've never tried. Or slow down and let Jesus come to you in a stranger.

At work, meeting with leaders during a downtown community meal, one of the guests asked if I'd watch her baby while she helped her two other kids get food. Little Juliana was quiet but observant, taking it all in, smiling that adorable baby smile they have. Watching her, I realized how sometimes I focus on the task at hand and miss the person, the reason for our action. I need contemplation to inform my action, and action to give my contemplation life. I pray that for Advent you include contemplation on Jesus' coming and action that cares for him in others.

RECIPE CORNER

Melt-In-Your-Mouth Pumpkin Cookies

Yield: 60 cookies

Ingredients:

- 2 cups butter, softened
- 2 cups granulated sugar
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 2 eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla
- 15-ounce can pumpkin
- 4 cups all-purpose flour

Frosting

- 1/2 cup butter
- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/4 cup milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 3 to 4 cups powdered sugar (add until desired consistency/firmness) ground cinnamon sprinkled on top (optional)

Instructions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

In a large bowl beat the 2 cups of butter with an electric mixer on medium speed for 30 seconds. Add granulated sugar, baking powder, baking soda, salt, the 1 teaspoon cinnamon, and the nutmeg. Beat until combined. Beat in the eggs and 2 teaspoons of vanilla until combined. Beat in pumpkin. Beat in as much of the four as you can with the mixer. Stir in remaining flour with a wooden spoon. Drop dough by heaping teaspoons 2 inches apart on ungreased cookie sheets. Bake for 10 to 12 minutes or until tops are set. Transfer to wire racks to cool.

For frosting, in a small saucepan heat the 1/2 cup butter and brown sugar until melted and smooth. Transfer to a medium bowl. Stir in milk and 1 teaspoon of vanilla. Beat in powdered sugar until smooth. Spread frosting on cookies.
