Lessons Learned on a Cruise


- 1. Time intentionally spent with family is a good thing.

DEACON'S REFLECTIONS

My sister's mom is dying. When we adopted a 4 year old girl, we knew next to nothing about her history. They said that her disabilities were possibly inherited from her mom. Maybe her exuberant laugh and joy of life were, too. Growing up, I was protective of my little sister when other kids stared or picked on her because of her speech or behavior or anything about her that they saw as being beneath them. It hurt, but we knew the truth: we gave her a home and she gave us love.

In her late 20's, my sister started asking about her birth mom. Our mother made inquiries and through a long process that almost didn't happen, my sister and her mom were reunited. I was there and will never forget it. They knew each other instantly; they have the same smile, same laugh, eyes and mannerisms. We met one of my sister's birth-siblings, learned of others, and exchanged photos and stories. Two families began the process of closing the gap of so many years and becoming one.

Birthdays, picnics, and cheering on our mutual Special Olympian all helped to make up for lost time. I got to know my sister's mom on a different level the day I recognized her and her friend among the guests at a community meal where I serve downtown. She became a semi-regular and always greeted me with a hug, asking how her daughter was. I'd send her home with extra food.

I can't imagine what it was like wondering about her daughter all those years, but I witness the joy she and my sister feel each time they're together. She does have some disabilities but in the grand scheme of things, they are as nothing. She loves her daughter, my sister. For that, I thank her.

RECIPE CORNER

Crazy Crust Pizza

prep time: 10 mins cook time: 30 mins total time

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 tsp Italian seasoning
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 2 eggs
- 2/3 cup milk
- 1/2 pound pork sausage, cooked and crumbled
- 1 cup pepperoni slices
- 1/3 cup diced cooked ham
- 1-1/2 cups pizza sauce
- 2 cups shredded mozzarella cheese INSTRUCTIONS:
- 1. Preheat oven to 425°F. Lightly spray a 15x10-inch rimmed baking sheet with cooking spray. Set

aside.

- 2. Whisk together flour, salt, Italian seasoning, pepper, eggs and milk.
- 3. Pour into prepared baking sheet. Top with sausage, pepperoni and ham.
- 4. Bake for 20 minutes.
- 5. Remove from oven. Spread pizza sauce evenly over pizza and top with mozzarella cheese.
- 6. Return to oven and bake 10 to 15 minutes, until cheese is bubbly.

To test if your oven is running cold:

- 1. Preheat oven to 375° . (186° C.).
- 2. Place a small amount of granulated sugar in an oven-proof dish or on a cookie sheet lined with aluminum foil.
- 3. Place in oven for 15 minutes.
- 4. If your oven is calibrated correctly, the sugar will melt.
- 5. If your oven is running cold, the sugar will not melt.

To test if your oven is running hot:

- 6. Preheat oven to 350° . (177° C.).
- 7. Follow the same procedure as above.
- 8. If your oven is calibrated correctly, the sugar will not melt (although it may brown a little).
- 9. If your oven is running hot, the sugar will melt. Note: ovens do not maintain a constant temperature, but cycle above and below it, so it is possible that the sugar may melt at 350° if your oven is correctly calibrated but has an extreme cycle (15° F, 8° C.).
