DEACON'S REFLECTIONS

On Friday, I spent time helping a community meals program plan how to continue serving those who rely on the meals. In light of the coronavirus, these leaders recognized the need for vigilance in keeping guests and volunteers healthy, while acknowledging that if the meals are cancelled, those same guests will go hungry. It was decided to temporarily change the meals from sit-down style to boxed meals that guests will take home. This is not ideal. Many guests are also fed by the companionship of dinner with friends. But for the time being, this is the best way to make sure they have the food they need and everyone remains safe. Kindness and friendly greetings will be more welcome than usual.

March 8-10, I was in Florida for a meeting of the Association of Episcopal Deacons, for whom I work part time. Fourteen of us from across the country worked on initiatives to support and strengthen deacons, and help others discern their call. As my Lyft driver Charles approached the hotel, I was stunned to see something that isn't possible in our winter climate: people living in tents on the sidewalks. They immediately entered my prayers, and now I find myself concerned for their health.

The virus is real, but so are the needs of our neighbours. We can adapt as we continue to help them — with prayer, food collections, pre-packaged donations and financial help for local agencies. We can be careful <u>and</u> compassionate.

RECIPE CORNER

Crispy Baked Potato Wedges

4 servings



Ingredients

4 small russet potatoes skin on

1/4 cup Parmesan cheese grated

3 tablespoons olive oil

1 teaspoon onion powder

1 teaspoon garlic powder

1/2 teaspoon parsley

1/2 teaspoon seasoned salt

Instructions

Preheat oven to 425°F. Wash potatoes and cut into wedges (depending on size, 8-10 wedges each). If time allows, soak potato wedges in cold water at least 30 minutes. Drain and dry very well with a kitchen towel or paper towels. Toss potatoes with remaining ingredients until well coated. Place potatoes, skin side down, on a large baking pan and bake until tender and browned, about 45-50 minutes.
